NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH DS20 (PART) SWANSCOMBE AND GREENHITHE) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2015

The above named Order made on 28th January 2015 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the entire width of that length of Public Footpath DS20 which commences at grid reference TQ 6098 7377 and runs in a southerly direction for 31 metres (across what is now the access road to the Eastern Quarry development) to TQ 6100 7374, and will add a new length of Public Footpath with a width of 2 metres which commences at TQ 6098 7377 and runs for 3 metres in a south-westerly direction along an existing footway to a dropped kerb crossing point where it continues in a southerly direction for 13 metres across a new access road to join the footway on the opposite side, then continuing in a south-easterly through south-south-easterly direction for 16 metres to re-join the existing line of Public Footpath DS20 at TQ 6100 7374.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

A copy of the Order and the Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Dartford Borough Council, Civic Centre, Home Gardens, Dartford, Kent DA1 1DR or at the Kent County Council, PROW and Access Service, Invicta House, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 1XX, during office hours. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased there at the price of £5.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent in writing to the Case Officer, Ms. Melanie McNeir, at the Kent County Council (address as below) no later than Wednesday 11th March 2015. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections or representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Kent County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH DS20 (PART) SWANSCOMBE AND GREENHITHE) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2015

This Order is made by the Kent County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of Public Footpath DS20 should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the definitive map and statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 046 (TQ67SW)) requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the public right of way into a fit condition for use by the public.

Dartford Borough Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act;

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the land situate at Swanscombe and Greenhithe and shown by a bold continuous line on the attached map contained in the Order and described in Part I of the schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 046 (TQ67SW)) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. The relevant date of this Order will be as specified in paragraph 1.
- 3. There shall be from the date of confirmation of this Order a Public Footpath over the land situate at Swanscombe and Greenhithe described in Part II of the schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 046 (TQ67SW)) shall be modified by adding the path to it.
- 3A. The Definitive Statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 046 (TQ67SW)) shall be modified as described in Part IV of the schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART I: DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The entire width of that length of Public Footpath DS20 which commences at grid reference TQ 6098 7377 and runs in a generally southerly direction for 31 metres (across what is now the access road to the Eastern Quarry development) to TQ 6100 7374, as shown between points A and B on the Order plan.

PART II: DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A new length of Public Footpath numbered DS20 with a width of 2 metres which commences at the previously described point A (TQ 6098 7377) and runs for approximately 3 metres in a generally southwesterly direction along an existing footway to a dropped kerb crossing point where it continues in a generally southerly direction for approximately 13 metres across a new access road to join the footway on the opposite side, then continuing in a generally south-easterly through south-south-easterly direction for approximately 16 metres to re-join the existing line of Public Footpath DS20 at TQ 6100 7374 (point B).


PART IV: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

STATEMENT TO ACCOMPANY

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH DS20 (PART) SWANSCOMBE AND GREENHITHE) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2015

THIS STATEMENT DOES NOT FORM PART OF THE ORDER

Under the Highways Act 1980, the County Council has the power to make Orders to create, extinguish or divert Footpaths, Bridleways and Restricted Byways. Legislation affecting this proposal is contained within Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The grounds for a diversion are that it is either in the interest of the owner/occupier of the land or of the public. It should, however, be noted that Section 119 also provides that the path or way will not be substantially less convenient to the public in consequence of the diversion and that it is expedient to confirm the Order having regard to the effect which the diversion would have on public enjoyment of the path or way as a whole. The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 amended the grounds by which a public path may be diverted.

The Kent County Council has made an Order to divert part of Public Footpath DS20 at Swanscombe and Greenhithe under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. This statement has been prepared to explain various aspects of the Order.

The application, which has been made by Land Securities Ltd., seeks to make a very minor realignment to Public Footpath DS20 as a result of a recently constructed access road leading to a new development. Although the construction does not obstruct the line of the footpath, it is considered in the public interest to make the minor modification shown on the attached plan in order that the footpath crosses the access road at a slightly safer point where there are dropped kerbs to facilitate access. The diversion proposed is de minimus and, as such, it is not considered that it would have any impact upon the convenience or enjoyment of members of the public using the route.

The Order will come into force only after the County Council has confirmed the Order and certified that the new route has been brought into a fit condition for public use; making and advertising the Order simply provides an opportunity for objections or representations to be made.

Persons considering objecting or making representations relating to the Order are invited to discuss their concerns with the Case Officer, Ms. Melanie McNeir, on 03000 413421.

Objections or representations relating to the Order must be made in writing to Ms. Melanie McNeir at the address below or by email to melanie.mcneir@kent.gov.uk no later than Wednesday 11th March 2015.

The right of an objection to an Order is a statutory right, but it should be exercised in a reasonable manner. The costs involved in dealing with objections to Orders may be awarded against objectors in cases of unreasonable behaviour.

If any objections are made and not withdrawn, the Council may refer the Order and objections to the Department of the Environment for determination. An Inspector from the Planning Inspectorate will then either take written representations or hear the objections at a Public Inquiry or Hearing. The Inspector can confirm the Order, confirm it with modifications, or refuse to confirm it. If no objections are received the Council may confirm the Order itself, but it has no power to modify Orders.

Attached are the maps and schedule covering your parishes for vegetation clearance. If you wish, you may ask that re change the paths that are included in this fixed part of the schedule but I am afraid that in can only be on a 'one metre in, one metre out' basis - there are no spare funds to increase the length of path that can be included in the fixed schedule.

In addition to the fixed schedule we have an amount set aside for reactive cuts to clear paths that are reported by users during the growing season, so the schedule is not quite the full picture.

Following the PROW meeting held at Southfleet village hall on 21st Oct, we have now received the minutes/notes from that meeting.


Would you please advise when the schedules and detail for next year's PROW cutting will be made available so that parishes can comment, as discussed at the meeting.
