3. ANNUAL ESTIMATES 2020 – 2021.

Further to minutes 305/19-20 (FGP 31 October 2019) and 377/19-20, 378/19-20 (full Council 11 December 2019) please find attached the proposed Annual Estimates for the 2020 - 2021 financial year (Annual Estimates provided with the preceding Finance & General Purposes Committee meeting paperwork).

4. COUNCIL TAX BASE 2020- 2021.

5. GROVE CAR PARK – REVIEW OF MANAGEMENT SCHEME (p).
