Crimes of note:

- 06/11 – Bodle Avenue – Criminal damage, paint thrown over car.
- 09/11 – Park road – Shed Burglary, Under Investigation.
- 10/11 – Milton Road, Business Burglary, Under investigation.
- 10/11 – Albert Road, Stolen Vehicle Located, stolen from London area.
- 13/11 – Durrant Way, Abstracting electricity, Multiple lines of enquiry explored however filed due to evidential difficulties.
- 15/11 – Keary Road – Vehicle Theft, Under Investigation.
- 18/11 – Park Road, Burglary, Under Investigation.

Anti-social behaviour and other incidents of note:

- Nuisance vehicles are still prevalent in Swanscombe.
- Multiple reports of incidents including shopliftings at the Co-Op, Swanscombe high street.
- 04/11 – The pavilion, the Grove – Nuisance youths – Police officers attended shortly after the call.
- 08/11 – Craylands lane – Nuisance bike. PCSO's attended shortly after call and were appropriately dealt with.
- Kent police have had multiple calls from Swanscombe residents relating to telephone fraud where caller pretends to be Amazon.
