Coronavirus Scam Warning
Watch out for these fake Tesco emails

Action Fraud has received 20 reports about fake emails that purport to be from Tesco. The emails allege that the supermarket is offering free vouchers during the coronavirus outbreak. The link in the email leads to a genuine-looking phishing website that is designed to steal login credentials as well as personal and financial information.

Be vigilant and do not click on links in suspicious emails and never respond to messages that ask for your password or financial details.
