PARKS REPORT RLA – 1 FEBRUARY 2018

Swanscombe Park:

The floors and walls of the bowls toilet block have been completely painted.

The damaged piece of play equipment is scheduled to be replaced w/c 12 February 2018 (insurance)

Play equipment, highlighted in the previous Annual Inspection Report, will be being painted over the next few weeks.

Manor Park:

As reported to the previous meeting a contractor has completed the recommended works on the row of trees bordering the houses (left hand side as you look at the park from Swanscombe Street).

Play equipment, highlighted in the previous Annual Inspection Report, will be being painted over the next few weeks.

Broomfield:

The large double garage doors have been replaced and include new securing latches for when the doors are both open and closed which should prolong the life of the doors by reducing the chances of the doors being damaged by the weather or "inquisitive" youths

Play equipment, highlighted in the previous Annual Inspection Report, has been painted.

The access way (Broomfield Road) running alongside the park has been thoroughly cut-back and cleared by the parks staff.

Knockhall:

After previous issues with a leaking roof the Parks Staff have installed a slanted roof over the referees changing rooms which has resolved the issue and should prolong the lifespan of the facility.

Further to minute 324/17-18 the fencing around the changing rooms was scheduled to be undertaken w/c 22 January 2018 but due to supplier issues the contractor has re-arranged this for w/c 12 February 2018.

Play equipment, highlighted in the previous Annual Inspection Report, will be being painted over the next few weeks.

PARKS REPORT RLA – 1 FEBRUARY 2018

Heritage Park:

The damaged large piece of play equipment was replaced in December 2017 (insurance claim).

The problem/damage by off-road motor bikes within the park is still ongoing. Parks staff are "patrolling" the area as much as is practical and incidents are being reported to the Police but it is difficult to know what other action/s can be taken without serious resource implications.

Saxon Court:

As reported to the previous meeting a contractor has completed the recommended tree works within the play area.

Play equipment, highlighted in the previous Annual Inspection Report, will be being painted over the next few weeks.

Valley View:

As reported to the previous meeting a contractor has looked at the trees in this area and a planning application (TPO) has been submitted to the Planning Authority for the works (minor) to be undertaken.

Play equipment, highlighted in the previous Annual Inspection Report, will be being painted over the next few weeks.

Grove Hall:

The Parks Staff have made, painted, and installed covers over the windows at the front of the Grove Hall and the Town Council are scheduled to work with the KCC Community Warden and Dartford Science & Technology College on their Community Day (18 July 2018) to have the front wall/s re-painted which will improve the aesthetics of the building/road.

Staff

Employee 63 has successfully completed their formal chemical/pesticide training (PA6a) which has increased the number (2 of the 3) of parks staff that are now qualified/able to undertake this part of the role which, in turn, should result in a visible improvement as more work will be able to be undertaken/completed.

Since the previous meeting there have been 10.5 days annual leave, 1 day sick leave, 3 days study/training leave within the parks department and 3 Bank Holidays.

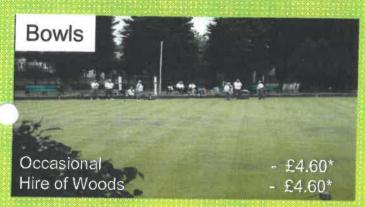


Recreation Facility Charges 2018-19
