3. ANNUAL ESTIMATES 2018 – 2019.

Further to minutes 306/17-18 (*FGP 2 November 2017*) and 369/17-18, 370/17-18 (*full council 14 December 2017*) please find attached the proposed Annual Estimates for the 2018 - 2019 financial year (*Annual Estimates provided with the preceding Finance & General Purposes Committee meeting paperwork*).
