Members were advised that the following planning applications had been received from Dartford Borough Council:

DA/13/00408/FUL Demolition of existing garages and erection 1 x 2 bed and 3 x

3 bedroom houses with associated parking and landscaping.

Block of 24 Lock-Up garages south west of Castle Street,

Swanscombe.

OBSERVATIONS: Members objected to the application in its current form on the

grounds that it was unclear as to how the application affected the alleyway access on adjoining roads and adjoining properties. Members recommended that a site meeting be held prior to the application being considered by DC Board. Members also requested that all neighbouring properties be notified of the application. Members also wished to express their disappointment with the development, as it appeared that work on site had already started prior to planning

approval being granted.

Members were asked to provide additional comment on the proposed access junction to the site.

Members' comments were that they did not believe that the design of the junction was appropriate, particularly with traffic light controls. They also felt that extensive traffic problems could be caused with it being so very close to another set of traffic lights. Members were of the opinion that a site meeting needed to called by Dartford Borough Council on the application, or the application be completely refused on the grounds of lack of appropriate infrastructure.
