Parks Report

The Annual Playground Inspection took place in March and we have received the report (this is an item later on the agenda)

- Swanscombe Park:

A new self-closing playground gate has been installed.

Parks staff have cleared the small branches and debris resulting from Storm Doris. The Tennis Courts have been treated for moss and algae and we intend to freshly mark the lines in before we open them at Easter.

Preparations are continuing in earnest on the Bowls Green with more work scheduled to be undertaken before the season starts.

There was an unsuccessful attempted break in to one of our storage units earlier this month which was reported to the Police.

A park user's car was in collision with the large gates leading to Park Road, causing damage to the gates. The driver reported the accident to park's staff and the gates will soon be repaired. This is subject to an insurance claim.

- Manor Park:

Painting of play equipment has been undertaken.

As previously agreed, the fence adjacent to Swanscombe Street is due to be replaced with steel bow top fencing this month.

- Broomfield:

As previously agreed, the tarmac surfacing work by the vehicle access, next to the garage at the rear of the Pavilion has been completed.

Staff have replaced the viewing bubble in the multi-play unit within the play area.

A new self-closing playground gate has been installed.

The football pitches have come through the winter well.

A small tree in Neptune Park was brought down in Storm Doris and has been cleared.

Preparations to the cricket pitch will continue over the next few weeks.

- Knockhall:

Two new self-closing playground gates have been installed.

Four pieces of outdoor gym equipment have been installed and are proving very popular with both adults and children.

Parks staff have installed a boot scraper close to the middle gate.

Shrubs overhanging from the Old Empire football ground have been cut back.

The security bar across the changing room door has had to be repaired due to wear and tear.

Due to a leak developing in the roof of the referee's changing room we will have the roof cleaned off and treated with a waterproof coating.

Both football pitches are in very good condition for this stage of the season.

- Heritage Park:

Unauthorised use by motorbikes continues to be a problem and staff have removed a burnt out motorbike from the park.

To try and make it harder for motorbikes to get in and out of the park wooden posts have been installed alongside the steps leading to the alleyway at the rear of Childs Crescent, hopefully this will deter motorbike users.
Information boards, marker stones and benches were heavily defaced with graffiti, which had to be removed by specialist contractors.

- Valley View:

A tree from neighboring land was blown over into the play area during Storm Doris and had to be removed by contractors.

A section of chain-link fencing was slightly damaged and has been repaired for now, with a view to replacing later on.

- Saxon Court:

As previously agreed the old wooden fencing adjoining Alkerden Lane is to be removed and replaced with metal bow top fencing.

- Equipment:

Both of the vans have passed the MOT test after a small amount of work.

- Staff:

A new member of staff is scheduled to fill the current vacancy with a start date of 5 April 2017.

She gets into a muddle and often wear my clothes back to front, she never know whether she is coming or going and often make the children laugh so much that it takes a week for them to stop smiling. Also provides Games - Magic - Puppets - Story Telling - Junior Punch & Judy Theatre. Songs and Dances.

Circus Sensible - Everyone will have the opportunity to learn a selection of circus skills, including diabolo, juggling balls/clubs, poi, stilts and spinning plates. Circus Time also carries out fire dance performances, make-and-do workshops and can provide stilt-walkers, as well as having contacts with a wide variety of other entertainers.

His friendly alter ego Marli The Magician performs at children's parties as well as at family functions. He offers a comedy magic show, balloon modelling and even party games to make your child's event a real success.

Animal Magic - Childrens entertainers based in East Sussex. We have built up a small collection of domestic and exotic animals that live with us as part of our family. We travel all over the South of England including Central London. We would describe our selves as a small travelling zoo. What started of as a hobby with one barn owl, a dog, a few rabbits and a pet rat some twenty years ago has now developed into something on a much larger scale with over thirty seven different species. With owls, parrots, South African Hedgehogs, Patagonian Maras, opossums, Meerkats, skunk. Lots and lots of domestic cute and cuddly for the little children. Snakes, lizards, insects, frogs, tortoises and crabs for the more adventurous The list just keeps growing.

We will come and visit you at the venue of your choice with as many or few animals as you would like to meet depending on the type of event you are holding.

Oreo and Friends – Would give a short talk which includes safety info then sit the children in a circle on the floor. Some of the animals are then put in the middle to run round , we put a mealworm path down and they follow that path and eat the mealworms, the children can reach out and stroke them and pick them up if they want to (meerkats, skunk, armadillos), then we pass tubs round with things like land snails and millipedes etc in, this needs no supervision and whilst that is happening we take around the snakes and lizards. After this we swap to mammals and again some can be passed round without supervision and others we take round such as the foxes, kinkajou, tenrecs. Oreo the raccoon will walk around the circle and take a tiny treat off anyone who would like to give him one, he is our superstar (Rocket Raccoons model in the Marvel film Guardians of the Galaxy) and our coati Hamish will happily walk around a circle of children who are standing up with arms outstretched.

Amazing Animal Encounters - The petting corner would be with two handlers. We would not be expecting for every child to handle every animal. Some animals they would be able to stroke with little additional supervision required. Over the course of two hours for an informal petting corner at an event with other attractions

Introduction to Inspections

Our Safety Inspectors are registered with the RPII (Register of Play Inspectors International) to their annual level and qualified to BTEC Level 3 advanced Playground Operation & Inspection. In addition to this they are also CRB checked and will carry their RPII identification with them. Authentic Inspection reports will show the inspector's personal RPII seal.

Unless otherwise instructed the playground equipment will have been assessed in accordance with BS EN 1176:2008 Playground Equipment.

The European standard was originally published on 1st January 1999 when the existing standards, BS5696, were withdrawn, and was revised in 2008. Equipment installed prior to 1 June 2009 may fail to meet BS EN 1176 in a number of areas. This does not mean that the equipment has become dangerous or that remedial action is required, provided that the equipment met the requirements of previous standards, i.e. BS EN 1176:1998, BS 5696/DIN. As an example, the majority of chains which where installed prior to the advent of EN 1176 will fail in relation to the gap in the links being in excess of 8.6mm. These chains need only be replaced when they are broken or worn, with new chains that meet the new standard requirements, however it would not be an issue requiring immediate action.

The risk criteria we apply in our inspection reports are as follows:-

Very Low – No remedial action is required

Low - Items are considered safe for use and require monitoring only as part of your regular inspection procedures.

Medium – Items require appropriate action within resources and individual site assessment. The equipment should be safe for use, but you must consider this in relation to your detailed knowledge of the site.

Medium High – Safe for continued use but remedial action should be planned or implemented within three months but again to be considered in respect to your detailed knowledge of the site.

High – Items require urgent action. The equipment should be immobilised or removed until repairs are carried out.

Where any compliance failures occur, these are briefly noted and a risk assessment made of the failure. Where we believe action is required, this is indicated in more detail and identified as a medium or high risk. In rare cases where an item is likely to result in major injury or death, the operator or appropriate representative will be notified from the site by telephone.

Where present, multi sports facilities and wheeled sports facilities and outdoor gym equipment will also be inspected and each area will be charged as a separate area.

Multi-Sports facilities will be inspected to BS EN 15312:2007.
