

NOTICE is given that the Kent County Council proposes to make the above named Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3, 4, 19, 65(1), 124 and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') as amended and all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order would be to prohibit certain vehicles from entry into the following length of roads in Dartford:-

ALKERDEN LANE – (1) No right hand turn into Colyer Drive except for buses, cycles and authorised vehicles. (2) No left hand turn into Colyer Drive except for buses, cycles and authorised vehicles. **COLYER DRIVE** – Install a bus gate for buses and cycles only from a point 22 metres south of its junction with Alkerden Lane for a distance of 100 metres in a southerly direction.
