TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Milton Street, Swanscombe will be closed to through traffic, on or after 1st December 2025 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed Between 74A and 74B.

The alternative route is via Milton Street, Ames Road, Lewis Road, Trebble Road and Alamein Roa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 08:00 hrs and 17:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway and footway investigation works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
